Bird Autumn Migration

Bird and waterbird migration begins in August and continues until mid-October. You can see flocks on the fields, preparing to fly away. On the seashore, there are various warbler-like birds - terns, warblers and seagulls of various species.

Our birdwatching sites include some of the finest birdwatching spots in Europe. With enthusiastic and professional birdwatching guides, it will be a perfect birdwatching holiday.

Tour example - Autumn Bird Migration in West Estonia

This tour takes you to some of the best places in Europe for sea duck and passerine migration. During the peak days up to half a million Chaffinches, tens of thousands of Siskins and a continuous chain of Long-tailed Ducks pass through the observation points in West-Estonia.

Fungi tours and Mushroom Foraging

Fungi tours and mushroom hunting tours are available from mid-August to early September. There are at least 4000 fungal varieties in our forests, with the most popular edible mushrooms being various Boletus and Chanterelles.

Over 100 fungi varieties can be spotted on a guided tour with knowledgeable mycologists. Both fungi tours and foraging tours will conclude with a delicious mushroom meal.

Tour Example - Mushroom Foraging Tour

On a guided mushroom foraging tour in the forests and bog islands of Peipsiveere Nature Reserve, you'll experience a scenic landscape free from artificial noises and likely devoid of other people. At the end of the hike, we'll build a campfire and serve dishes made from local food, including mushrooms.

Astronomical Tours

Meteor showers occur in August and September, with dark nights revealing stunning stellar skies in October. The Baltic countries are excellent destinations for stargazing, thanks to their low light pollution and expansive open spaces.
